


 To make sure your child won't miss out on exciting trips or events happening in your school you can use the Aladdin App on your phone.








Enter your **email** address

Click Create Account




You now have your Aladdin account :

Click install




When the app is installed **open the app.**

Password (the one you used to set up your account)









To make sure you get notified when a new message has come into Aladdin

4. Click on Allow notifications and App icon badges






When you have those settings updated you will see little icons on your phone when a new message comes into Aladdin.
